But today, a new generation is rising, bringing the reo back to their whānau, helping it grow strong once more.

Materials You Will Need

- Paper plate
- Googly eyes could draw these on if you don't have any
- Coloured tissue, magazines, specialty papers etc
- · Coloured card or paper for tail and beak
- Glue stick
- Scissors
- Pencil

O1 Fold plate in half and cut the angle of the face.





Rip and cut your papers to stick on.



O3 Cover one side in glue — or you could do the whole thing at once.



O4 Stick and layer your papers down like feathers.



O5 Cut tail shape and Sellotape to the inside of the plate.



Fold small piece of paper and cut an elongated triangle around the fold for a beak. Now glue one side of the triangle to the face over the collage.





O7 Glue googly eyes above the beak.





Kua mutu, you're all done!
